THE SUMMER PROGRAM

Village Glen Tennis Club Summer Tennis Camp, under the direction of Stephen Sayoc, is the most comprehensive junior program in Western New York for beginner through tournament level tennis players. Our three tiered program, **PEE WEE/LEVEL 1, JUNIORS and TOURNAMENT TRAINING**, is tailored to accommodate junior participants of all levels between 4-18 years of age. The groups are based on the same "level structure" used during our Fall/Winter program. Call now if you are unsure of your child's level for a *free* 15-minute placement evaluation. Our final evaluation will be on Saturday, June 20th from 10 - 12pm and 2-4pm at the Glen.

PEE WEE & LEVEL 1

- Pee Wee ages 4-6, Level 1 ages 6-8
- Classes: Monday - Friday
- Time: 9a.m. - 10a.m.

PEE WEE (ages 4-6 years old) is designed to introduce young children to tennis. The lessons are taught on a court 1/2 the size of a regular court and small racquets are used. Ball and racquet handling are emphasized. Strokes are introduced. **Level 1** (ages 6-8 years old) is designed for students that are ready to start working on strokes and strategies.

JUNIORS CAMP (Level 2-4)

JUNIORS CAMP is designed for players who are ages 8 and up, levels 2 through 4 CPDP. Level 2 (minimum age 8) is designed to develop strokes and introduce specialty shots and tactics. Level 3 (min. age 9) will focus on diversity of strokes, spins, higher level strategy and situational drills. Level 4 consists of intensive drills and match ready coaching for advanced level players.
